### **Ofsted Inspection Outcome – Codsall Community High School**

We are delighted to announce that we can now share the outcome of our most recent Ofsted inspection that took place at the beginning of March. The inspection was a fully graded inspection and was undertaken by a team of four inspectors who spoke to students, observed lessons, looked at books, spoke to governors, parents and staff.

Inspectors graded the school as **“Good”** in every category.

Some key findings were:

- “Pupils are proud to be a part of this vibrant school.”
- “Leaders have high expectations for all pupils, and pupils live up to these expectations.”
- “Pupils feel safe at school.”
- “Bullying is rare, and when it does happen pupils report it because they know staff will deal with it. Pupils are well-mannered and respectful, and they engage well in lessons.”
- “They (students) behave well and know that the staff have their best interests at heart.”
- “Leaders have high expectations for pupils’ behaviour and conduct. These expectations are applied consistently and fairly by staff.”
- “There is an active focus on teaching and supporting pupils to improve their behaviour and become active positive citizens. This means that pupils rarely make the same mistake again.”
- “The personal development curriculum is ambitious.”
- “Sixth-form students prosper throughout their time at the school. They are motivated and engaged in lessons. The curriculum they study is ambitious, and its content is regularly reviewed.”
- “Many students use their enrichment time to give something back to the school. For example, many volunteer to help and support their younger peers to prepare for exams or to complete subject coursework.”


