## **Curriculum Update for Year 10**

As you know, your child has been studying their accelerated option during Years 9 and 10. Over the next few weeks they will finish their accelerated course.

One of the many benefits of an accelerated option is it frees up time later on for core subjects, which are essential for sixth form, college and employment, and it enables students to choose intervention sessions to help them catch-up or to excel in their other courses. The table below shows how this works:

Year 10	Three lessons for the accelerated option each week

	Two lessons of Core PE each week	
Year 11	One extra lesson of Maths and Science each week	
	Four lessons for intervention options including Core PE	

Students can choose from all the core and option subjects they are studying (see below) and Core PE for each of their four intervention lessons.
