MID-DAY TRANSPORT FOR EXAMS AND REVISION SESSIONS

Students who catch existing transport – whether county-council provided coaches, the 710 bus or school minibuses, will continue to enjoy access to these services at the existing times to facilitate students getting to/from school in the mornings.

Year 11 students have been allocated to revision classes which often run in the morning directly before an afternoon exam, or in the afternoon before a morning exam the following day. Resultantly, for the vast majority of revision classes or exam sessions, students who need transport will be able to catch the existing transport at the normal times. There are a small number of morning exams where students do not have an afternoon activity – for these exams, we have arranged school minibuses to take students home, or afternoon exams than run over the usual departure time of buses. Students who have a revision class in the middle of the day or the afternoon should *not* catch transport home and should attend their revision class as scheduled.

On Tuesday 06 June, Thursday 08 June and Friday 09 June, some students who catch the morning transport may have a revision class that doesn't start until period 2 or 3; on Wednesday 7th June, History & PE students have a gap between their morning Maths exam and the afternoon revision classes; on Friday 16th June, Design Technology students have a gap between their morning Science/Physics exams and their afternoon DT revision class. For these students, we have arranged for the dining room to be available to them as a study space. They should register with Student Services and then go to the dining room where they will be supervised, have access to water and toilets and be able to revise from the books/practice material brought with them whilst waiting for their revision class to start.

The schedule for the additional transport runs is shown below, with buses leaving Codsall going to Sainsbury's in Perton and, if required, to the Co-op in Pattingham. Should students who usually catch coach or bus transport home experience any other problems with transport as a result of exams overrunning, they should go to Student Services in the first instance as they will be able to offer assistance. Students who attend school after registration either for an afternoon exam or for a mid-day revision class should enter via the blue gate closest to Student Services.
