The Duke of Edinburgh's Gold Award 2024

Dear Parent/Carer,

Following on from the presentation to Year 12 students last week I am pleased to be able to offer a limited number of places for the Gold Duke of Edinburgh's Award to students in Year 12. You do not need to have completed Silver to participate but the award would take longer to complete.

The cost of the award will be £450. This covers registration, equipment, campsite fees, first aid training, and assessor fees. A non-refundable deposit of £75 is required by 8th December 2023 with three further payments of £125 due on 1st February 2024, 1st April 2024 and 1st June 2024. All payments will be made via Parent Pay. If your child is eligible for sixth form bursary and you require financial assistance, please contact the Headteacher, Mr Maxfield.

There will be an initial meeting for students after school on 14th December 3pm - 4pm in the library to ensure all the students are registered and know what they are doing for each of the sections. Students will then take responsibility themselves for ensuring they complete their sections and upload the necessary evidence to DofE. Any student who requires additional support can contact Mrs Freeman on sfr@sslp.uk or in the library with any concerns.

After Easter there will be a further training day and two after school route planning sessions. If any students choose to enrol who have not completed Bronze or Silver Awards there will be additional after school sessions, these will be arranged directly once we know who this involves. It is a requirement to attend all of the training.
