Mock Exams and Self-Isolation

Today some students in Year 11 had to self-isolate following a positive test for Covid-19.

These students will be returning to school on Thursday 3rd December which coincides with the start of the mock examinations. Before this they will be able to take part in online lessons (see www.cc-hs.com/blended) to continue their learning and preparation for their mocks.

If there are further cases of Covid-19 this might mean some students in Year 11 are not in school when some of their mocks take place.

If this happens these students will take any mocks they missed in the first available slot when they are back in school. There is space in the mock timetable for this to happen as students typically have one paper lasting 1¼ to 1¾ hours each day, leaving the remaining time available to catch up on missed papers, if needed.

If a student has to self-isolate for longer than we can accommodate in this way we will prioritise the first paper for each subject before Christmas and students will complete the remaining papers when they return to school in the first week back after the Christmas holiday.

Whenever a mock is rescheduled your child will receive a message through EduLink from Mrs Page, our Examination Manager, so they are aware of when their rescheduled mock will take place.

I hope you find this letter is useful in outlining the steps we have put in place to ensure the mocks, which so many students are preparing for, can go ahead.

Finally, we would like to thank you for your continued support. We understand the difficulties you and your child face when they self-isolate and the sacrifices they make to keep themselves, their families, fellow students and communities safe.
