Join the Degree Course at Wolves

Despite all our students being based at home during the lockdown we are still taking applications for students who are looking to kick start their career in sport from September. The Foundation are recruiting now for any students who are ready to join the highly successful football coaching degree based here at Molineux Stadium.

Run in partnership with the EFL Trust and University of South Wales, the three-year degree programme offers students the chance to engage with the football club whilst combining their studies with work based opportunities through the club. The unique nature of the course allows students to engage in an online learning model where lectures and assignments are completed.

Students embed their learning through practical work-based opportunities within the many projects delivered through the Foundation. Modules covered on the programme include Football Event Management, Introduction to Sports Development, PE and School Sport & Project Operations Management.

Here at Molineux we run lectures in our purpose-built study centre and during the academic year students spend a minimum of five days per year at the USW Sport Park as part of two annual residential trips to the University to experience student life.
