

Sixth Form Dress Code – Codsall Community High School

“Dress for Business”

We feel that our students should be professional in their approach to their work and being “business smart” is an important step in ensuring that the students feel prepared for their day of work. We believe that the code will create a purposeful work ethos and positive atmosphere, whilst setting a good example to the younger students.

MALE

- Smart business trousers – Black
- Collared Shirt – short or long sleeve, polo acceptable – no slogans
- Smart jacket – Black, no denim or leather
- Tie (optional, but must be a dark colour)
- Formal black shoes, no canvas
- Tailored black, knee length shorts may be worn in summer

FEMALE

- Smart dress or skirt of a suitable length – Black
- Black or neutral tights with skirts if desired
- Smart business trousers – Black
- Formal black shoes with a low heel, no canvas
- Smart, professional top
- Smart jacket – Black, no denim or leather
- Tailored black, knee length shorts may be worn in summer
- No leggings or jeggings

Headwear

No hats or caps can be worn in the school building.

Hair

Normal range of coloured hair.

Jewellery

- Jewellery must not be excessive i.e. no large hooped earrings
- Jewellery must be kept to a safe standard
- No facial piercing will be permitted.

Accessories

Headphones, MP3 players and mobile phones are only permitted in the Sixth Form Centre.
