Aims and Ethos

The Codsall Community High School uniform policy is designed to promote equity, a learning ethos and a sense of community amongst all of our students. Students should take pride in wearing their uniform both inside and outside of school and they are reminded that they are representing our school when they are doing so.

The uniform policy has been formed in compliance with the statutory guidance on the Cost of School Uniforms (2021) [<https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/cost-of-school-uniforms/cost-of-school-uniforms>] and the Equality Act (2010) [<https://www.legislation.gov.uk/ukpga/2010/15/contents>], to ensure that uniform is affordable and does not discriminate students based on their protected characteristics.

Main Uniform
Trutex Contemporary graphite grey jacket (badged)
Trutex grey tartan skirt (minimum 182 long)/Trutex Contemporary matching graphite grey trouser
House tie
Plain white shirt
Black socks or tights
Marl grey v neck jumper (no logo)
Sports Kit
Trutex navy and aqua polo shirt panelled (badged in house colour)
Trutex navy panelled skort/shorts
Trutex navy tracksuit pant with piping/Navy Trutex leggings
Navy contrast top sports socks
Trutex navy midlayer badged in house colour
Shoes
Shoes must be black and polishable, with no clear brandings.
Hair and Jewellery
Hair must be within the natural range of colours and not extreme in style.
One stud earring in each ear is acceptable. For safety reasons, no other piercings are permitted.
